Plug in the power and turn on the hairdresser.</div><div>2. The default value is 180 ° after startup.</div><div>3. Select the appropriate temperature by pushing the switch.</div><div>4. Push down to turn off the hairdresser.</div></div></div></div></div>		<div><div><div><div><div><div>1. Please turn off the switch before cleaning.</div><div>2. Please have the equipment cooling down first before touching or cleaning the surface</div><div>3. Wipe the surface of the appliance with a clean and slightly damp cloth.</div><div>4.
